EXPLORING OUR LENTEN WILDERNESS

Can you believe it is Lent already? Some of you may be asking, what is *Lent*? Short version is: it's the time of year we set intentions (give something up, take on a spiritual practice, etc.) to make us aware of our humanity and our human finitude. For this reason, we begin the season on Ash Wednesday hearing the words "From dust you came and to dust you will return," or "Ashes to ashes, dust to dust."

It is an interesting season because as we are called to face our sinfulness, we are also reminded of our beloved-ness. Two sides of the same human coin. We are deeply loved by God and we are made painfully aware that we are not God, we fall short.

Sometimes we can get stuck in that second part and become withdrawn, complacent, and static. We see huge problems in our world: broken relationships, violence, personal loss, war, prejudice, poverty, hunger, etc., and we refuse to engage because we don't know how.

That's why we chose Brené Brown's book, Braving the Wilderness, for this season. It's a field guide for engaging the wildernesses of our lives and of our world. For Brené, it all starts with her quest for true belonging (which is a quest I think we can all relate to). So just as Christians around the world are wrestling with the tension of beloved-ness and sinfulness, Brené gives us this beautiful little book on belonging and wilderness. During this season at Greystone, there are several opportunities for you to read and discuss the book with others (see the Faith Formation column on page 3). Themes from the book will also appear in worship and Wednesday Night Live gatherings. If you'd like to pair scripture with the book study, consider reading the scriptures for worship each week (listed to the left) and ask God to speak to you through scripture as we remember the ancient stories of wilderness trials and allow them to inform our present-day wilderness temptations.

So, with a generous grant from the Lilly Endowment in 2012, the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship established the Fellows program for new ministers in their first full-time ministry position after seminary.

I am honored to have been selected to participate in such a valuable and meaningful program. I am grateful to Greystone Baptist Church for providing me support through the program as well as allowing me the space to attend the remaining five gatherings in person. I look forward to opportunities to share what I've learned with the congregation.

A Minister Encouragement Team has been set up to help me reflect on what I learn and how it can be applied in the context of serving at Greystone Baptist Church. The Minister Encouragement Team will meet following each Fellows gathering and consists of Barbara Crabb, Lorri Heilig, Carla LeNoir and Donnie Moorefield.

The next Fellows gathering will be February 25 - March 1 at the CBF Church Works conference in St. Louis, MO. Church Works is a CBF continuing education for congregational ministers. I will be attending breakouts with other CBF Youth ministers during the conference.

Additional gatherings for CBF Fellows are CBF General Assembly in June 2019, a stand-alone Fellows gathering in October 2019, CBF Church Works in March 2020, and CBF General Assembly in June 2020.

Thank you for continuing to encourage and support me as I grow professionally and spiritually through this opportunity.
