#### Sermon Series: Faith Through Fear

"Fear is a self-imposed prison that will keep you from becoming what God intends for you to be. You must move against it with the weapons of faith and love." -Rick Warren

"Do not fear" is perhaps the most frequently repeated phrase in all of scripture. Yet as we look out into our world, we see people, communities, and even nations living and acting in fear. We are afraid of financial crisis. We are afraid of the Coronavirus. We are afraid of the upcoming general election (no matter which party wins). We are afraid of war. We are afraid of losing the people we love. We are afraid of our unknown futures. And if we rely only on ourselves to solve the problems we see and to prevent the outcomes we fear... we should perhaps be afraid.

In scripture, however, we read story after story of a God who remains with, who guides, and who cares for the people. In God's constant presence we see miracles happen. In scripture, we read about a God who delivers captive Israel from Egyptian slavery and who provides for them in the wilderness. We read about a God who brings dry bones to life again. We read about a God who provides sight to blindness, and a God who's final word is "resurrection" after Jesus dies on a Roman cross. Scripture tells the story of a God who is always working among us, around us, and within us, bringing new possibilities to life so that we don't have to be afraid.

During the season of Lent (Feb 26 through April 12) we will read these stories from scripture and consider how God is working to guide us through our fears, leading us to deeper faith... and hopefully leading us to a spiritual place where we can proclaim with the women who went to the tomb that first Easter morning, "I am not afraid!"

Prayer for Lent: God, as I look around I can see that there is much that scares me. Be my stronghold during those fearful moments and remind me that you are always with me. Show me the times when my faith falls short, when I tend to act in fear. In those moments, help me to boldly and bravely trust in you to fill those spaces with compassion and courage. I believe, help my unbelief. Amen.

In the midst of everything that threatens to undo us, how can we thoughtfully and carefully build habits and spiritual practices that will draw us deeper into faith? Reverend J. Dana Trent will lead a series of Wednesday nights that encourage and enlighten us in this critical task, and she will be our guest proclaimer for worship on March 8. We will be working through her book, "One Breath at a Time". Join us for this time of learning and spiritual development as we journey through this season of Lent.

Rev. Trent is a graduate of Duke Divinity School and professor of World Religions and Critical Thinking at Wake Tech Community College.
