

For twelve years, David further expanded his pastoral experience as the leader of First Baptist Church in Huntsville, Alabama.

In 2014, David transitioned from pastoral ministry and joined CHC when his wife, Jane, assumed the role of pastor at Union Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in Watkinsville, GA. In addition to his consulting work, David has contributed as an Adjunct Professor at McAfee School of Theology of Mercer University and served as an Interim Pastor in various churches throughout the Southeast.
